




#### Steve Bell - England Member of the Jury




#### Maira Kalman - USA Member of the Jury





#### Tan Oral - Turkey Member of the Jury

Among the awards he has received are the "Golden pen Award" (2001) at the Deventer Cartoon festival in Holland, the "Best foreign Newspaper Cartoonist Award" (2003) in Aksehir the "Cartoonist of the Year Award" (2004) of the Ankara Cartoon Foundation, the "Service Award" (2004) of Eskisehir Anatolian University, and the "people at the Top Award" (2005) at a public voting competition organized by Nokta Magazine. Tan Oral has had his works published in many channels of the press, including the newspaper politika, and has had a daily cartoon series printed in the newspaper Cumhuriyet. Some of his works have been compiled in his books - "Buyuk Tukiye" (Big Turkey) :Sansur (Censor) "Sus ve Dinle" (Be Quiet and Listen) "Istanbul" "pencereler"(Windows), "Yuruyenler" (Thos Who Walk), "Yaza Cize" (Writing ,writing) "Bu Kitabin Kuyrugu Var" (This Book has a Tail) and "Yuz Yuze" (face to face). Tan currently lives and works in Istanbul as a freelance cartoonist and draws for Taraf Newspaper.






#### Hideo Takeda - Jaban Member of the Jury
